



Autism Assessment Process for Adults in Leicestershire



Gather information

Create a list of any difficulties with social communication, social interaction, rigid and repetitive behaviours, and sensory sensitivities detailing lifelong impact. Include childhood history and development.

Speak to your GP

Referrals to the
Adult Autism
Assessment
Service usually
come from the GP
or adult mental
health team.

Fill in questionnaires

You will be sent multiple questionnaires to fill in. Try and do so with as much information as possible. Consider the benefit of why you may need a diagnosis.

Initial Assessment

If the referral is accepted you will have a short appointment to gain information around possible autism. You will need to take someone with you who has known you for a long time. They will have to answer questions about you. You may be discharged after the initial assessment.

Full Assessment

A half day
assessment usually
with a consultant or
one of their team
members. You will
need to take
someone with you
who has known you
a long time. You
may or may not
receive a diagnosis
after this stage.
