Working with Partners and Stakeholders

Initial meetings took place with the new interim Chair for the LLR Integrated Care Board and with the new Chair for UHL/UHN.

Chair/NED Appraisals, Recruitment and Succession Planning

Following a formal process of review and approval, NHSE have agreed to extend Faisal Hussain's tenure as a NED to 30 September 2025 to maintain consistency of support for the joint Chair role under our Group arrangements.

The Chair's appraisal was submitted to NHSE in line with national process and timescales. NED appraisal discussions have all taken place. Appraisal documentation will be finalised in the coming weeks prior to reporting the conclusion of the NED appraisal process to NHSE at the end of September.

Board Development

A workshop on 6 June provided Board members with an opportunity to hear from and explore with Deloitte their initial findings from the Trust's Well-Led Review. LPT colleagues participated in a similar opportunity on the same day. This was followed up by joint workshops with LPT Board members on 25 June and 23 July to consider the synergies with the initial findings for both Trusts and start to develop shared improvement plans.

The joint development sessions also included a focus on developing a joint strategy for 25/26 and Patient Safety Incident Response Framework (PSIRF) training aimed at Board members, delivered by the Health Services Safety Investigations Body.
