**Purpose of the Report**

The report assures that the Trust is meeting The Medical Profession (Responsible Officers) Regulations 2010 and the GMC (Licence to Practice and Revalidation) Regulations 2012.

**Analysis of the issue**

The Board is asked to approve this report (noting that it will be shared with the higher level Responsible Officer) and to sign the ‘statement of compliance’ (Section 4) confirming that the organisation, as a designated body, is in compliance with the regulations.

Leicestershire Partnership Trust has a prescribed connection to 145 doctors for the purpose of Medical Revalidation, with the General Medical Council (as of 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024). 139 doctors were appraised in the appraisal year.

The figures contained within this report are correct as of 31 March 2024. Numbers refer only to those doctors who have a prescribed connection with the Trust. Medical Trainees on the approved training programme are excluded as they are connected to Health Education England East Midlands.

**Proposal**

The aim of this paper is to provide an annual report to the Trust on progress in implementing and managing appraisal and revalidation for doctors that have a prescribed connection to the Trust. It provides an overview of the elements defined in the Responsible Office regulations.

The Annex A – Professional standards framework for quality assurance and improvement document reflects the template prescribed by NHSE to assure the Trust and higher-level Responsible Officer of the effectiveness in supporting medical governance in keeping with the GMC’s requirements.
